- Identifies and reports campus safety and security hazards.
- Must know and adhere to the Standard Operating Procedures of the SAGU Security Officer.
- Possess strong sense of integrity, highly aware of surroundings, able to communicate clearly and capable of handling life-threatening situations; technical skills including knowledge of firearms, familiarity with restraining devices and understanding of security technologies; physical strength, ability to remain standing for extended periods of time.
- Must be able to react quickly, calmly and professionally in emergency situations as required.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

- Current Armed Licensed Level III Commissioned Security Officer with Texas Department of Public Safety (Preferred) or Law Enforcement Officer

- Ability to work harmoniously with faculty, staff, administration, and students
