

Licensed Vocational Nursing Instructor Qualification Requirements

Travel Required: Wichita Falls and Vernon

Experience and Training: Unencumbered licensure as a registered nurse in Texas. Minimum of three years' experience in a clinical setting.

Education: Bachelor's degree in nursing or an Associate's degree in nursing with completion of Bachelor's degree within 5 years. Current LVNs may be considered.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities: Ability to communicate effectively. Current CPR certification. Flexibility with hours. Computer skills including use of Microsoft Office applications. Ability to promote an effective learning environment for students from diverse cultures and backgrounds.

Preferred Qualifications: Bachelor's degree in nursing and two years teaching experience. Three years medical/surgical, long term care, pediatric, and/or obstetric nursing experience preferred.

Minimum Educational Qualifications: Associate's degree in nursing with completion of Bachelor's degree within 5 years. Current LVNs may be considered.

Maximum Educational Qualifications: Master's degree in Nursing

Salary or Salary Range: This is a full-time 12-month faculty position with full time benefits. This position is available for internal candidates only. The salary for this position is based on the faculty salary schedule. The salary is \$52,152 – LVN/ step 3, \$55,488 -Bachelor's degree/step 3 to \$62,472 – Master's degree/step 5. Salary is based on education and experience. Internal applications will be accepted until March 27, 2026. This position is available on May 11, 2026.
